the application as his/her legal residence and be a customer of the city.

(3) The customer's total gross annual income and retirements benefits, including the total gross annual income and retirement benefits of those who live in the applicant's residence, shall not exceed:

\$ 11,770 for a single person	\$ 28,410 for a family of five
\$ 15,930 for a family of two	\$ 32,570 for a family of six
\$ 20,090 for a family of three	\$ 36,730 for a family of seven
\$ 24,250 for a family of four	\$ 40,890 for a family of eight

Applicants who meet the above three provisions will qualify for the rate; current rates are available by calling a customer service representative at 438-5244.

The applicant's age must be verified by identification. Physically and mentally disabled applicants will be verified by the Social Security Administration. Income and retirement benefits will be verified by requiring applicants to provide a copy of their previous year's state or federal tax forms. The City Manager has the final review of all applications and will notify all applicants of their status within 30 days of receiving the application.

Applications are available in City Hall Monday - Friday 8 am - 5 p.m. Completed applications should be returned to the customer service office at City Hall.
